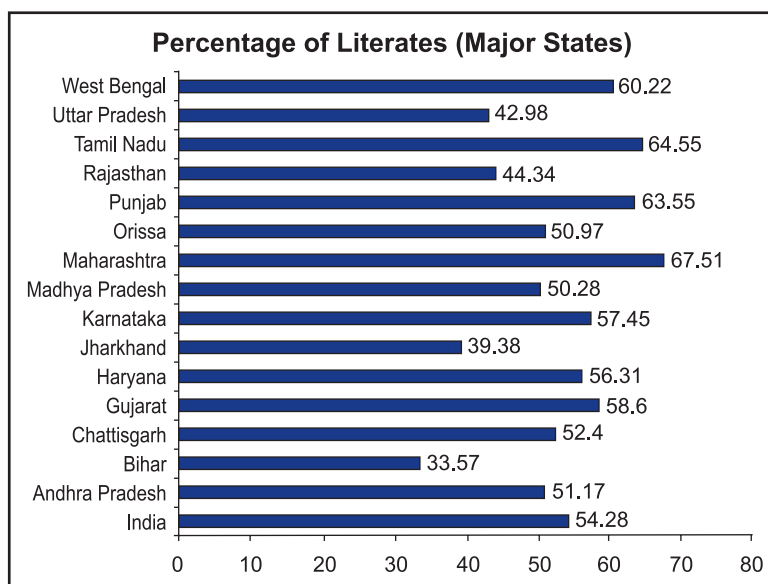

## Socio-Economic Indicators

Socio-economic indicators provide a background to understanding the health scenario in a country. This section on Socio-economic indicator provides data on education, gender, poverty, housing, amenities, employment and other economic indicators. These indicators for the country as well as states will help in identifying the linkages between socio-economic indicators and achievement of health goals.

- ❑ The literacy rate in the country has shown an increase of 13.86% during the decade (1991-2001) and is 64.8 per cent, 75.3 for males and 53.7 for females.
- ❑ The Primary Enrolment Ratio in 2000-2001 was 2826.47 for the age group of 6-11 years with 2475.99 for boys and 2640.26 for girls.
- ❑ 27.09% of population in rural area and 23.62% of urban areas live below poverty line according to planning commission estimates for the year 1999-2000
- ❑ The Gross National Product for the year 2005-06, at factor cost was Rs. 3178769 crore at current price and Rs. 2566756 crore at constant price (base year 1999-2000). The Net National Product at current price was Rs. 2854683 crore and Rs. 2304043 crore at constant price.
- ❑ The Per Capita Net National Product at current price was Rs. 23241 crore and Rs. 12416 crore at constant price.



- ❑ In 2001 55.85% of total household had electricity, 47.4% of the total household had permanent housing facility.
- ❑ In 2004 a total habitation of 422293 was covered under Rural Water Supply Programme. 62.30 proportion of population had an access to safe drinking water.
